## MANAGEMENT OF THE SPREAD OF THE CORONA VIRUS AND CURRICULUM DELIVERY AND ASSESSMENTS

In accordance with the presidents' speech in terms of strong personal hygiene, a responsible approach in social interaction and school closure on Wednesday 18 March, please take note of the following:

### Managing the spread of the corona virus :

Everyone has to take personal hygiene, especially the regular washing of hands, for at least 20 seconds at a time very serious. Our learners have been provided with extra hand sanitizer to encourage the habit and to make them aware to use it after they have used the bathroom and before they eat.

The use of tissues or coughing and sneezing into the flexed elbow must be reiterated and become part of the norm.

Changing our social interaction, no physically touching, or hugging must be encouraged as being socially responsible. Our learners still make light of it and does not necessarily understand the severity of the situation.

Should your child feel sick in the second term, please do not send the child to school. Not only will it make your child vulnerable, but it will also make anyone who has to care for your child vulnerable. It is sometimes difficult to judge, but we advocate a cautious approach.
